The Centre offers a Plus Fitness Gym, English Language School, and Women's Sewing Centre. They also produce fresh vegetables from on-site gardens.

Education is an important area in the developing nation and ATLAS is proud to be a part of such a worthwhile project that includes:

- English School students attending classes twice a week for 2 hour sessions.
- Classes are now run from Monday to Friday again, after they were forced to close during the COVID lockdown.
- Students ages vary from children as young as five, through to thirty year old adults.
